STUDENT RESPONSIBILITIES



- Own the Process!
 - Have you verified the accuracy of your transcript?
 - Are you taking a rigorous academic program?
 - What steps have you taken to research schools and complete applications ontime?
 - Have you started working on your college essay?
 - Student-Athletes, have you filed with the NCAA?
- Communicate and Monitor!
 - Have you made an appointment with the College Office?
 - Have you requested official SAT/ACT/AP scores to be sent to colleges and the NCAA?
 - Do you know which of the schools you are applying to require supplemental essays?
 - Do you know how to utilize Naviance to request recommendation letters and transcripts?
 - Dates and Deadlines

4 year colleges

- Extracurricular activities

2 year colleges

- Transcript
- Standardized tests (used for placement)

COLLEGE & PPLIC & TION OPTIONS



- **Regular Decision**: "I am interested and if accepted, I might want to attend."
- Early Action: "I am very interested and if accepted, I will most likely attend."
- Early Decision: "It's true love, and if accepted, I *must attend*, because it is *contractually binding*." (ED I & II)
- Single Choice/Restrictive Early Action: "I'm very interested, and you're the one and only school I may apply to early." (Non-binding)
- **Rolling Admission**: "I must apply as soon as possible because applications are reviewed and decisions are made on a rolling basis."

COLLEGE & PPLICATION PROCEDURES



All college application related materials will be submitted electronically through Naviance. This includes the following:

- Transcripts
- Teacher recommendations and evaluation forms
- Counselor recommendations and secondary school reports
- Other relevant college documents (Early Decision agreements, Fee Waivers, etc.)

COALITION APPLICATION

- The platform provides a single, centralized toolkit for students to organize, build, and refine their applications to numerous institutions. Coalition schools graduate at least 70 percent of their students within six years, with many having much higher graduation rates. There are currently over 140 Coalition member colleges across the country.
- The application is completed online and can be accessed by logging onto <u>www.coalitionforcollegeaccess.org.</u> Some schools will accept the Coalition application in addition to other applications, such as the Common Application, while other schools are exclusive and therefore, require students to use the Coalition application.

 - Available 10/01/2019 www.fafsa.ed.gov
- NYS Tuition Assistance Program (TAP)
 - New York's grant program that helps eligible NYS residents attending NYS institutions
 - Grant based upon NYS taxable income
 - Available 10/01/2019 (FAFSA MUST BE COMPLETED FIRST) www.hesc.ny.gov
- CSS/ Financial Aid Profile
 - Nearly 400 colleges & universities use the profile to distribute nonfederal student aid funds
 - Available 10/01/2019


