Senior Symphonic Band Program Notes

España Cañi.....Pascual Marquina (1873 - 1948)
arr. Robert Longfield

The *paso doble* (or *paso dobles*) is a Spanish couples dance. It is highly stylized and modeled after the entrance of the matador as a bullfight or his passes right before the bull is killed. *España Cañi* is one of the most famous tunes used for the dance. Written around 1925, it means "Gypsy Spain."

Superman.....John Williams (b. 1932)

In 1978, composer John Williams finished writing the music for the movie *Superman*. It is interesting to note that Robert Bedford, Clint Eastwood, and James Caan were all offered the title role for the film. They all turned it down, citing reasons from "I'm too busy" to "I'm not getting into that silly suite!" Christopher Reeve accepted the role and became the new Superman, while John Williams cemented his title as the "Superman of Movie Writers."

Our Yesterdays Lengthen Like Shadows.....Samuel R. Hazo (b. 1966)

The Huntington High School Senior Band would like to dedicate tonight's performance of *Our Yesterdays Lengthen Like Shadows* to Eli Mollineaux.

Our Yesterdays Lengthen Like Shadows was commissioned by the 2008 South Carolina All-State Band. It is a very unique composition in that it begins with one note, ends with that same note, and this note never stops throughout the entire length of the piece. However, after the first two measures, the listener is no longer aware that this one note is being sustained due to the introduction of chordal melodies. These melodies and harmonies that occur around this note symbolize the events and experiences in our lives. The one ever-present note symbolizes *you* - just one part in a complex movement of auditory shapes. The listener doesn't notice the note after its introduction, but if the note were taken out, its texture would immediately be missed.

Nemesis.....Gary D. Zlek (b. 1960)

In Greek mythology, Nemesis was the god of retribution and vengeance. It has come to mean an unstoppable foe, an unbeatable rival, an implacable enemy. This piece is based on a descending three note motive. It is marked "with malice", and is highly volatile in nature, projecting the powerful and ominous feelings associated with the title.

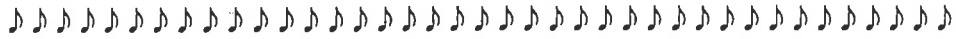
