The Tri-M Music Honor Society, the only national honor society for student musicians in grades 6-12, is a program of the National Association for Music Education (NAfME) which focuses on creating future leaders in music education and music advocacy. Tri-M is designed to recognize students for their academic and musical achievements, reward them for their accomplishments and service activities, and to inspire other students to excel at music and leadership. With more than 1,800 chapters across all 50 states, Tri-M involves more than 75,000 secondary music students. Sharing and supporting the objectives of every dedicated music educator, Tri-M works to increase student and school involvement with music and to make a stronger and more unified school music program.

Each year, students in Tri-M throughout the country contribute more than 750,000 service hours to their schools and local communities and raise nearly \$1 million for causes they care about. Huntington Tri-M students participate in numerous community and school service activities. Students perform at the Carillon Nursing and Rehabilitation Center, mentor primary and intermediate students in private music lessons, participate in the annual Safe Halloween at the high school, and work at the All-County festivals and NYSSMA solo and ensemble festivals hosted by Huntington.

To be accepted in Tri-M, student members must be enrolled in at least one music class for at least one semester, have at least a 2.0 GPA in their core classes and a 3.0 in their music class(es), and be of strong character. Huntington students are also required to perform a NYSSMA solo or ensemble selection at levels 4, 5, or 6 in the school year prior to submitting their application.

Tri-M was founded in 1936 by Alexander and Frances Harley, incorporated and renamed Modern Music Masters in 1952, and recognized in 1983 as the Tri-M Music Honor Society, a program of The National Association for Music Education. The Tri-M Music Honor Society logo is rich in symbolism. The three M's stand for "Modern Music Masters," the society's original name. Music is represented by the lyre and the scroll, which denote accomplishment and service. The five lines of the music staff indicate the five criteria upon which members are selected: scholarship, character, cooperation, leadership, and service.

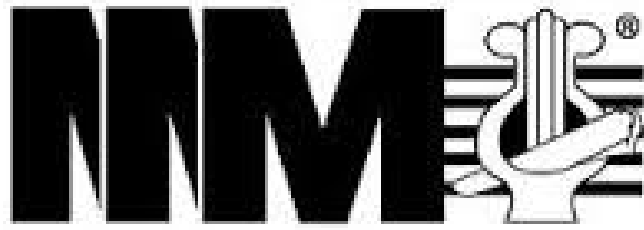
