

Section XI Guidelines for Spectators

- Please stand and remove headwear during the playing of the National Anthem.
- Refrain from using noise makers or sound devices, the stomping of feet, taunting, using foul and/or abusive language, inflammatory remarks and disrespectful signs and behavior. Violators will be warned and then removed from the athletic contest.
- The use of noise makers or sound devices by spectators is strictly prohibited.
- Observe and obey the rules previously established regarding smoking, food, and drink consumption, and parking regulations and procedures.
- Demand a sports environment for the child that is free from drugs, tobacco and alcohol pursuant to the District's Code of Conduct.
- Respect and obey all school officials, supervisors, security, and police at all athletic contests.
- Encourage good sportsmanship for all players, coaches, and officials at every game, practice or other sports event.
- Place the emotional and physical well being of the students participating first.
- Support the coaches and officials working with the children and encourage a positive and enjoyable experience for all.
- Encourage sportsmanlike behavior from all participants and other spectators.
- Students in attendance at away contests are expected to display proper behavior. Referrals by opposing schools may be subject to discipline.

Remember that an athletic contest is only a game—not a matter of life or death for player, coach, school, official, fan or community.
