- 8. Continue to provide and augment relevant and engaging professional learning opportunities designed to support staff member growth and morale, with a focus on differentiated and innovative instructional practices, as well as learning relevance.
- 9. Review and improve district "wellness" practices and initiatives; work with food-service provider to evaluate and improve the district's food service program in terms of student appeal and nutritional value.
