Action Plan:

- 1. A parent survey will be sent out to determine the remote learning needs of our community.

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<u>SMART Goal</u>: To focus on the social and emotional learning and well-being of all Southdown Students.

Action Plan:

- 1. Shared Decision Making members will dedicate a portion of each SPLASH assembly to social and emotional learning. The topics will be tied to the Sanford and Harmony program.
