## HUNTINGTON HIGH SCHOOL 2018 SUMMER DRIVER EDUCATION APPLICATION

The Huntington Union Free School District Summer Driver Education Program is currently open to any student who has reached the age of 16 by June 25, 2018 and holds a valid learner's permit. **Registration for the <u>2018 Summer Session</u> will be as follows:**

<u>Students must register themselves and they are **not** permitted to leave 9<sup>th</sup> period early to line up</u>. A numbered ticket will be given to each registrant. HHS Seniors graduating in 2019 will register first, then HHS Juniors '20, then HHS Sophomores '21 and then all others. There are 48 openings which will be filled on a first-come, first-served basis.

The course will run from June 25<sup>th</sup> through August 2<sup>nd</sup>. No class will be held on July 4<sup>th</sup>, but the mandatory make-up date is July 20<sup>th</sup>. All other make-ups may be held the week of August 6<sup>th</sup>. Lecture classes will be conducted each day Monday through Thursday and students must attend all four days. Road Classes will be conducted twice a week. Class time will depend on an individual's schedule. Individual schedules will be assigned on a first-come, first-served basis on the day of registration. Once you are assigned a schedule, you may NOT change once the session starts. Please see scheduling information on the back of this page.

Students may miss a total of **three** classes. On the day that a student has lecture and road, if the student is absent it counts as **two** absences. Missed classes must be made up immediately. Once a student misses the **third** class, they will be <u>dropped</u> from the program and will not be eligible for the course completion certificate (MV-285). **CLASSES CANNOT BE MADE UP ONCE A NEW SEMESTER BEGINS**. Therefore, it is extremely important that a firm commitment be made as to a student's attendance. Also, please note that it is the student's responsibility to provide transportation to and from the program. Please be advised that the registration fee of \$500.00 (HHS Student) and \$525.00 (Non-HHS Student) will not be refunded once the program has begun. The following requirements must be completed in a satisfactory manner to receive the MV-285 certificate: 24 hours of lecture; 24 hours in the car.
