Dear Parents/Guardians,

You are cordially invited to attend our annual Meet the Teacher Night at Huntington High School on Tuesday, September 27, 2016 at 7:00 p.m. Classroom visits will begin promptly at 7:00 p.m.

Classroom presentations are designed to allow our teaching staff to give parents a brief overview of their curriculum goals, students' expectations and grading practices. If you would like to talk about individual issues with any of your child's teachers, you may schedule a meeting or phone conference. **On the night of the 27<sup>th</sup> you will also be able to sign up for parent-teacher conferences which are scheduled for the morning of November 8, 2016.**

A brief guidance information session regarding the PSATs will be provided throughout the evening in the library. Parents of 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> grade students who would like to register for the PSAT exam may also do so. As a reminder, payments must be made by check or money order, payable to Huntington High School in the amount of \$29.00. We will also be conducting registration for the Mock ACT exam for 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> grade students, scheduled to be administered on Saturday, November 19, 2016 at 8:45 a.m. The cost for the ACT Mock exam is \$10.00 and should be made payable to Huntington High School by check or money order. As a reminder, the 9<sup>th</sup> grade **Parent Night** sponsored by the Guidance Department is scheduled for Thursday, October 27, 2016 at 7:00 p.m. and will outline your child's guidance program over the next four years. If at any time you need to make an appointment with your school counselor, feel free to call 673-2011 or 673-2013.

Please have your child fill out the enclosed form by writing in the schedule that he/she follows on an **"A" day**. Extra copies of your child's schedules will also be available at the entrance of the building. Classes will be eight (8) minutes in length (see attached bell schedule) instead of the usual 42 minutes. If, on the **"A"** day, your son/daughter is assigned to a lab we recommend that you report to Physical Education, support classes and/or S & O courses that are usually scheduled opposite the lab. On the back of this schedule you will find a map of the school which will assist you in locating the classrooms.

Please remember that if it is necessary for a student to leave school during the day, the following procedure must be followed: Students must come to school with a note stating the reason you will need to pick them up from school. This note must contain the specific time you intend to pick up your child and must be brought to the Attendance Office (room 117) first thing in the morning. The student will then be given a pass to leave class at the specific time and will be waiting to be picked up. This procedure will **avoid having to call into the classroom and interfere with the lesson**. **When picking up, you must come in through the main doors of the building and sign your child out of school from either the front desk or the nurse's office.** Please remember to make doctor appointments for after school or on non-school days whenever possible.
