June 25, 2012

A Special Meeting of the Board of Education of the Huntington Union Free School District was held on Monday, June 25, 2012 at Jack Abrams School, Huntington Station, New York. The meeting was called to order at 7:37 PM.

ROLL CALL

There were present Board of Education Members: Rogan, Paci, Black, Brown, Hebert, Spector; Trustees Elect, DiGiacomo and Palacios; Gregory Guercio, Esq., Superintendent Polansky, Dr. Card, Dr. Giani, Mr. Grackin and Mrs. Troffa. Mr. McGrath was absent.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Mrs. Rogan led the Board of Education and the others present in the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag.

EMERGENCY EVACUATION PROCEDURE

Mrs. Rogan discussed the exits to be used in the event of an emergency.

SMOKE-FREE SCHOOL DISTRICT

Mrs. Rogan announced that the Huntington Union Free School District is a smoke-free district and smoking is prohibited in all buildings and on school grounds. She also asked that all cell phones be turned off.
