On behalf of the guidance department, we are partnering with Revolution Prep to assist our students in becoming better prepared for the ACT exam. Therefore, on **Saturday, January 12th, 2013**, we will be conducting a full-length mock ACT exam at Huntington High School. This practice exam will provide each student with the valuable experience of taking the ACT.

Approximately one week following the administration, we will host a review session for students and parents, and we will distribute student score reports as well as discuss how to interpret the results.

Interested sophomores must complete the attached form and submit to Mrs. Walter in Guidance West no later than Thursday, December 6th.
