If you are dropped off or are a walker, you should arrive between 9:10-9:20 am. Throughout the year, please make every effort to be here on time and not leave until dismissal. All dentist and doctor appointments should be made after 3:45. Permission notes **must** be sent in with your child if they will be going home with another parent/student, taking a different bus or being picked up. To prevent an illegal absence from being recorded, call the **attendance** line **673-2039** or bring in an absent note when you return to school. Tardiness and early pick up (before 3:35) will be reflected on report cards as instruction will be missed. Please help us maximize the school day with your cooperation in these procedures. The **transportation** newspaper has been sent out. If you have any questions about bus stops or times, please call **673-2032**.*

*Our "Meet the Teacher" nights have been scheduled for the **5th grade, Monday, September 19th at 7:00 pm** and **6th grade, Monday, September 26th at 7:00 pm**. Our ESL parents should arrive at 6:30 for translation and the curriculum of ESL classes. At "Meet the Teacher" night parents will be able to sign up for a parent/teacher conference in November.*

At Woodhull we believe communication is essential. Homework folders and agenda books will be sent home daily from teachers, please make a habit of checking backpacks every night.
