



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WHATIS THEPSAT?



The PSAT/NMSQT®



- **❖** The PSAT = Preliminary SAT
- NMSQT = National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test
- (They're the same test.)
- The PSAT/NMSQT is administered in October.
- **❖** 10th and 11th graders take the PSAT.
- The PSAT 10 is the PSAT, but for sophomore test-takers only.

The PSAT is the National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test (for juniors!)

But less than 1% of scorers in each state earn scholarships.

Limited subject matter

Content knowledge

Plenty of time to complete

Partial credit

One element of overall grade

Standardized Tests

Years of material...

... hidden behind testing strategy

Rigorously timed

Partial answers lead to traps

Only your final score matters

THE PSAT IS SCORED SIMILARLY TO THE SAT

SAT 400-1600

PSAT/NMSQT 320-1520

SAT Scoring





SAT Scale: 400-1600

Scaled scores are comprised by summing the section scores

Reading & Writing: 200-800

Math: 200-800

Questions have varying weight

My score isn't what I wanted...


That's what prep is for.

ACT Scoring

- * ACT Scale: 1-36
 - o English 1-36
 - Math 1-36
 - o Reading 1-36
 - Science 1-36
- Section scores are averaged for a composite out of 36
- Questions all have equal weight
- Optional Essay
 - o scored separately on a scale of 2-12



So what's a good score on the SAT or ACT?

Agood score is the score that gets you accepted.

Your PSAT is the first step on your testing and college application path.

√ Take the PSAT

Compare your PSAT score to the school profiles on your college list.

Commit to the SAT or ACT (or both).

Plan your prep timeline and get the scores you need.

Submit scores when applying to college.





Test Required, Test Free, Test Optional?

93% of all schools will want to see high test scores if students submit them

96% of those schools with <25% acceptance rate want to see high scores

How Optional is Test Optional?

By the time you apply, the current policies at your target schools may change. Stay apprised.

You should choose to submit scores on a caseby-case basis.

You should make these choices with a trusted advisor.

So should I take the SAT, ACT, or both?

ACT vs SAT – What's the same?

They're both scaled exams.

Both are "tightly timed."

They both test English grammar, reading comprehension, and math.

They both allow calculators.

Neither penalizes wrong answers.

Both taken at a testing site, proctored in-person.

ACT vs SAT – What's different?

The SAT is a digital test.

SAT math problems are generally a little bit longer.

The SAT has a built-in Desmos calculator.

The SAT is shorter.*

The ACT can be taken on paper or on a computer.*

ACT tests a few more math concepts, and more plane geometry.

The ACT has a science section.*


Verbal sections have different formats.*

SAT & ACT Section-by-Section

The SAT is a computer adaptive test.



SECOND MODULE

More difficult overall

SECOND MODULE

Less difficult overall

You cannot guess the difficulty of your second module.

You can only focus on the questions you are given.

But wait... the ACT is changing!

If you're in the Class of 2026 or below...

45 A C D E

- 1. The ACT will be shorter, going from about 3 hours to about 2 hours.
- 2. The Science Test will become optional.
- 3. The English, Reading, and Math Tests will have fewer questions.
- 4. It will be offered in both online and paper & pencil formats.
- 5. The scoring scale will remain the same.



Implementation Timeline

NO changes to the paper & pencil ACT through July 2025

The online (computer-based test) launches in April 2025

Starting in September 2025 all national test administrations (both paper & pencil and online) will be the new, shorter ACT

School-day administered ACTs

– whether on paper or online –
will not change until Spring 2026


