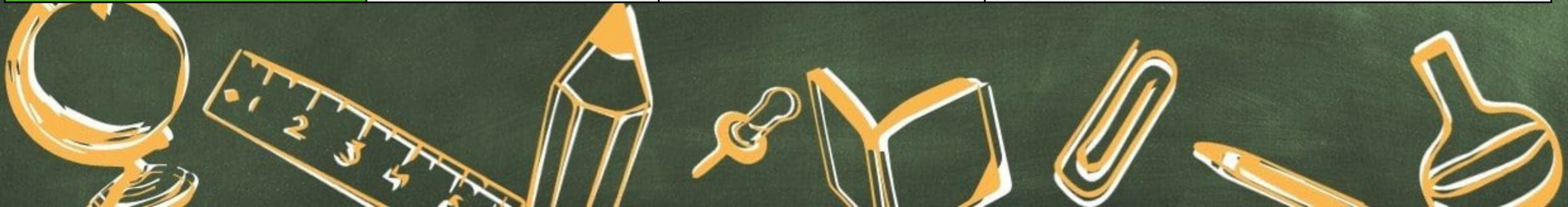
NYS Diploma Requirements

- To earn a New York State (NYS) diploma, students must meet credit and exam requirements. These requirements are separate and distinct and do not have to happen simultaneously.
 - Students must complete a minimum of 22 credits in specific subject areas.
 - Students must pass specific Regents exams, depending on the type of diploma they are pursuing.
 - Regents Diploma – Pass 5 Regents Exams with a score of 65 or higher.
 - Regents Diploma with Advanced Distinction - Pass 8 Regents Exams with a score of 65 or higher.

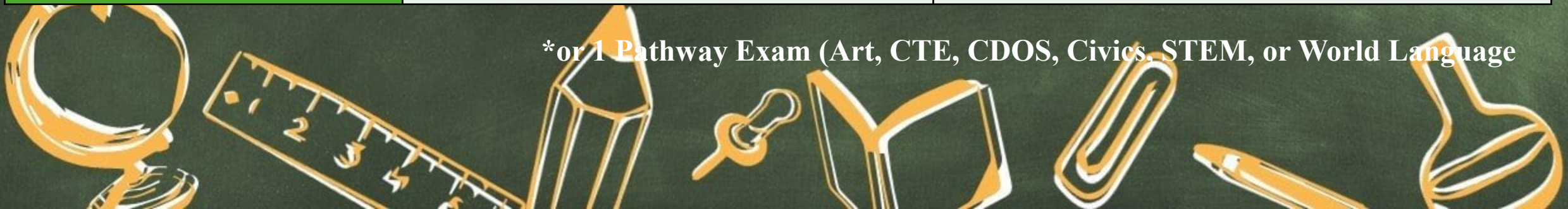

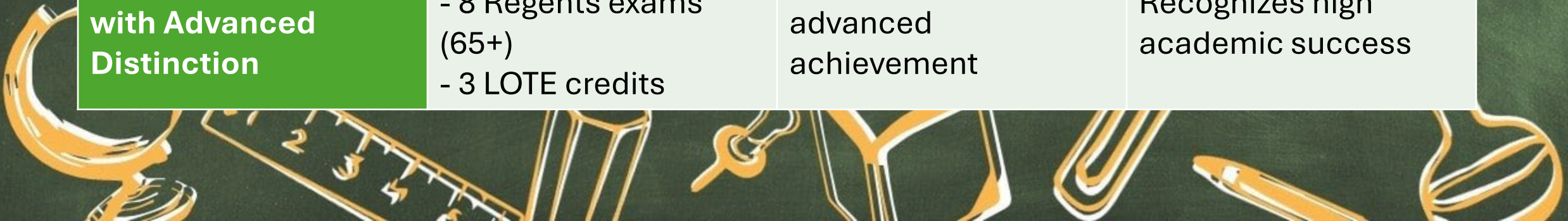

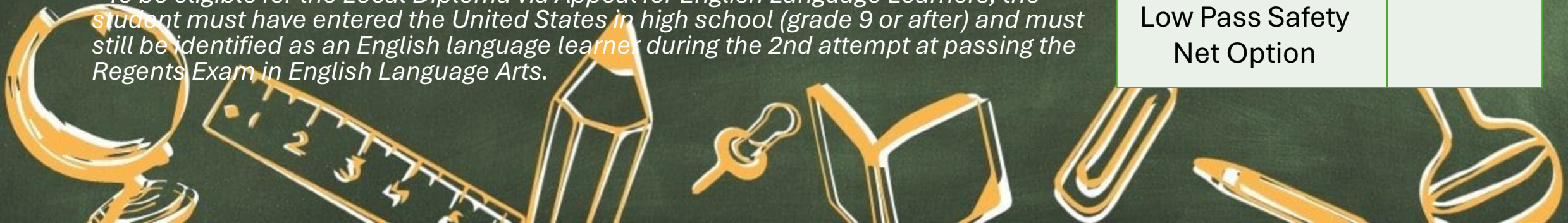
Traditional Appeals

All New York State students are eligible to appeal a lower score on a Regents examination if they meet the following criteria:

- Have taken the Regents examination under appeal at least two times;
- Have at least one score on the Regents examination under appeal within the point range appropriate for the appeal:
- Have taken advantage of academic help provided by the school in the subject tested by the Regents examination under appeal;
- Have passed the course for which the appeal is being sought; and
- Have been recommended for an exemption to the graduation requirement by the student's teacher or Department chairperson in the subject of the Regents examination under appeal.

** To be eligible for the Local Diploma via Appeal for English Language Learners, the student must have entered the United States in high school (grade 9 or after) and must still be identified as an English language learner during the 2nd attempt at passing the Regents Exam in English Language Arts.*



Requisitos del Diploma del Estado de Nueva York

- Para obtener un diploma del Estado de Nueva York (NYS), los estudiantes deben cumplir con los requisitos de créditos y exámenes. Estos requisitos son separados y distintos y no tienen que cumplirse simultáneamente.
 - Los estudiantes deben completar un mínimo de 22 créditos en áreas temáticas específicas.
 - Los estudiantes deben aprobar exámenes específicos de Regents, dependiendo del tipo de diploma que estén persiguiendo.
- Diploma de Regents: Aprobar 5 exámenes de Regents con una calificación de 65 o más. Diploma de Regents con Distinción Avanzada: Aprobar 8 exámenes de Regents con una calificación de 65 o más.






