Rohan Murphy is a decorated Long Island high school wrestler and extraordinary power lifter. His story is one of success due to his incredible drive and perseverance, for Rohan had both of his legs amputated at age four. He brings his story to students to show them that "their obstacles in life aren't something to be ashamed of. These things should drive you to want to improve."

Rohan has been featured in Nike's "No Excuses" ad campaign and Sports Illustrated, and was interviewed for a "20/20" TV segment. He was a Bronze medalist in the 2006 Junior Division World Powerlifting Championships and trained for the 2012 Paralympics in powerlifting.
