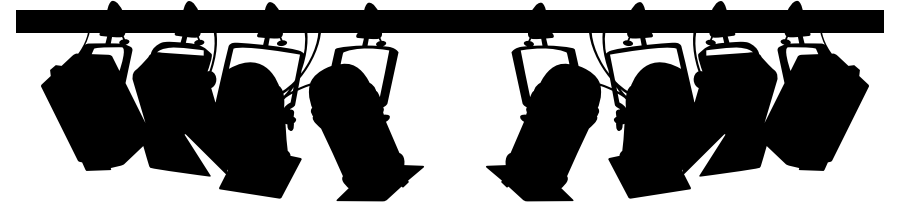

### Director's Notes

When he's not in school, Isaiah enjoys cooking and volunteering. He wants to thank his mom for always picking him up from Drama Club.

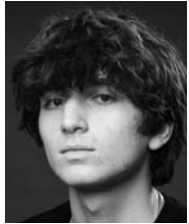

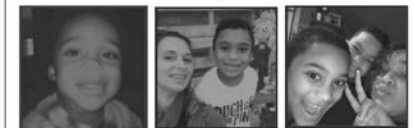
