The Blue Devil athletic program at Huntington High School and J. Taylor Finley Middle School is set for 2026/27 with junior varsity and varsity football teams kicking off practice on Monday, August 17 and all other high school sports beginning on Monday, August 24. Finley teams will open the fall season when classes resume.

During the 2026/27 school year, Huntington UFSD will offer students a comprehensive athletic program that includes 36 varsity level teams; 16 JV teams and 25 middle school teams for a total of 77 Blue Devil athletic teams.

The Blue Devil's philosophy, program objectives and core values are all closely aligned with the Huntington School District's overall mission and have been emphasized with coaches, who are sharing it with the student-athletes under their direction.
