1. Formulate and implement a school reopening plan and procedures based on such core guiding principles as safety, flexibility and quality of learning opportunities.
2. Build capacity to address students' social/emotional needs and learning loss resulting from the COVID-19 pandemic.
3. Further explore and establish culturally responsive and transformative K-12 learning environments designed to meet the needs of individual learners within a diverse school community.
4. Further upgrade/enhance technological infrastructure/hardware/applications to allow for high quality remote learning experiences and seamless transitions to remote learning, with focus on means through which to promote and maintain teacher-student and student-student connections.
5. Build upon existing means of home-school communication and collaboration in an effort to address family needs under the current pandemic conditions and beyond.
6. Provide relevant and engaging professional learning opportunities designed to support hybrid and remote instructional delivery and staff social/emotional health.
7. Continue to broaden hiring and retention practices supporting a highly qualified staff, upholding consideration toward its reflection of the district's culturally diverse population, that collectively help students to reach their academic and personal potential.
8. Seek ways to maximize revenue and manage expenses during a short- and intermediate-term fiscal downturn in a manner that allows for purchase of needed equipment and PPE, as well as maintenance of staffing and programs.
