Assessment:




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SMART Goal: By the end of the 2022-2023 school year, the Southdown school community will participate in monthly book talk's and read alouds celebrating students' character built through character trait conversations and literature.

Action Plan:

- ✓ Students who continue to exhibit the monthly character trait will be recognized at our monthly SPLASH assemblies.
- ✓ Students who continue to exhibit the monthly character trait will participate in making the morning announcements each day.
- ✓ Second and third graders will be reading buddies with Kindergarten and First graders to model what the monthly character trait looks and sounds like through children's literature.

Assessment:

By the end of the 2022-2023 school year, students will have a good understanding of ten character traits taught and modeled to them by teachers and peers throughout the school year. This will be evidenced through a student survey completed in May of 2023. This survey will identify the positives and also the next steps for building students character.

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
