By June 2026, Huntington High School will increase meaningful family and community engagement by implementing at least three targeted initiatives designed to strengthen communication, participation, and partnership with ALL families. Success will be measured by a 5% increase in family participation across school-sponsored events (academic, cultural, and extracurricular), improved family feedback scores on annual climate surveys, and expansion of multilingual outreach efforts to ensure equitable access for all families from grades 9–12.

- Bilingual Communication (Newsletters, emails, texts, etc.) sharing school updates resources, and opportunities for involvement.
  - Neighborhood Aide Evelin Vilorio will engage with families and promote school events and initiatives.
- Explore incorporating Child Care services into evening events (if feasible)
- Enhance and expand Celebration of Culture Event
  - o Broaden participation to include families from all schools and grade levels across the district.
  - o Increase promotion and outreach to encourage community wide involvement.
- Create opportunities for cultural performances, showcases and exhibits that highlight the diversity of our district.
- Implement Family Events focused on academics, college/career readiness and student well-being with interpretation services available.
  - o Plan for a career fair after school hours during the Spring of 2025 2026
  - o Connect with local companies that have internship/apprenticeship opportunities available.

### **Assessment**: (How will we know if the goal was met? What can be measured?)

- A 5% increase in family participation at school-sponsored events (academic, cultural, and extracurricular).
- Improved family feedback scores on the annual climate survey.
- Documented growth in multilingual outreach, including translated materials and interpretation at events.
