Recognizing the strengths of our district's traditions, its history of community support, the diversity of our population and our commitment to educational excellence, the mission of the Huntington Union Free School District is to educate students by effectively teaching an enriched body of knowledge through the active participation of all students, building upon their unique talents and abilities to produce creative, self-assured, responsible citizens who are capable of critical thought and action.

Our District

The Huntington Union Free School district, is located in Western Suffolk County, NY, on the beautiful North Shore of Long Island, approximately an hour east of New York City. The district is proud to boast cultural diversity as a cornerstone, encompassing families from the varied facets of Huntington, including Huntington Village, Huntington Station, Huntington Bay, and Halesite. Approximately 4,130 students are educated in HUFSD, from grades Kindergarten - 12, and an additional 162 populate their Universal Pre-K program. There are eight schools in the district, including four primary schools (Flower Hill, Jefferson, Southdown, and Washington, grades K-3), two intermediate schools (Jack Abrams STEM Magnet school and Woodhull Intermediate, grades 4-6), one middle school (J. Taylor Finley, grades 7-8) and one high school (Huntington High School, grades 9-12).
