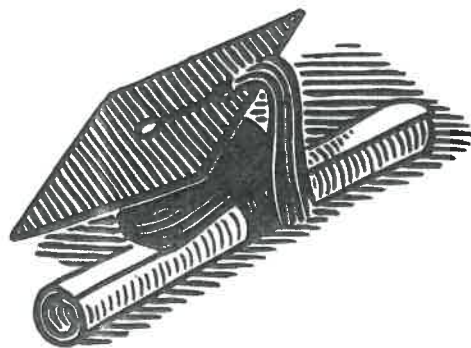


Jack Alba

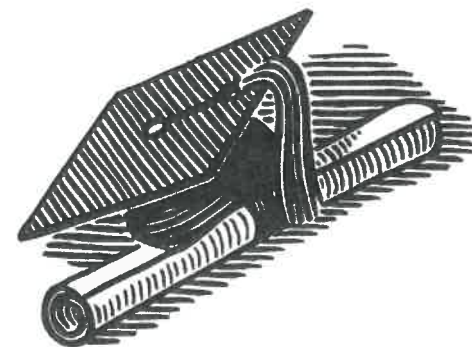


Nina Varvatsas

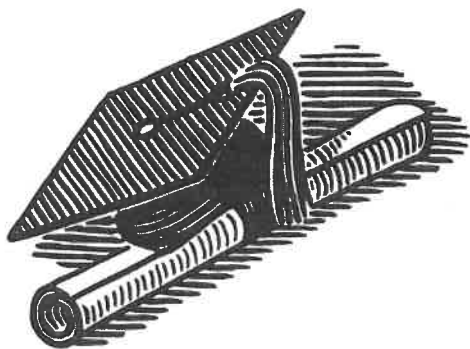


Felipe Villanueva

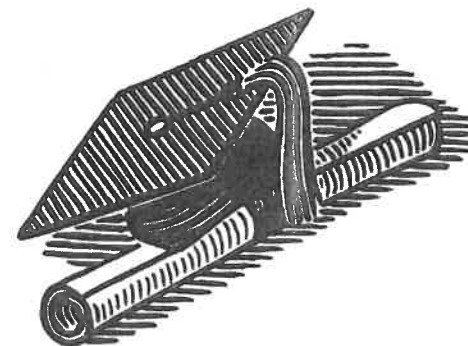
Joseph Sclafani

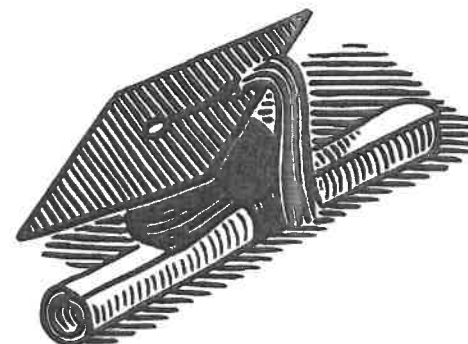

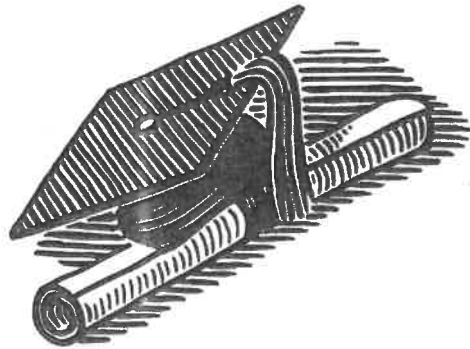

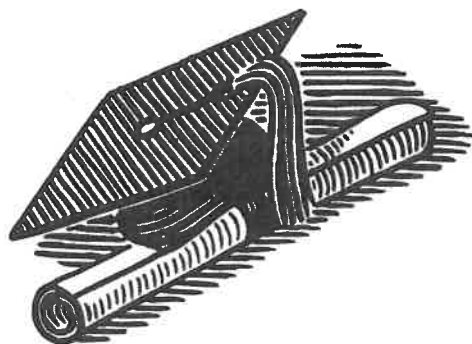


Keylin Quintanilla Villalobos

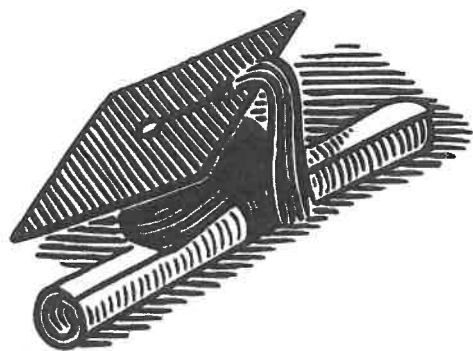


Caroline O'Rourke

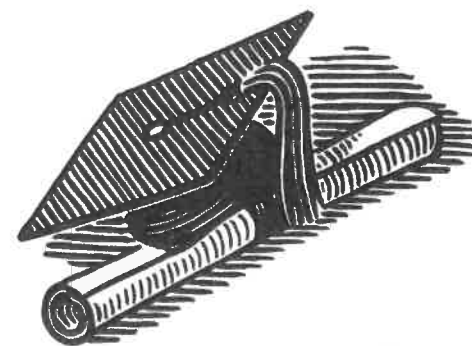


Grace McCallion

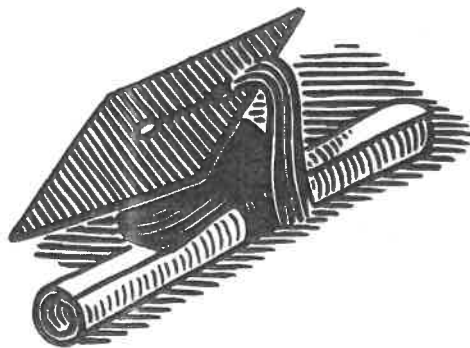


Charles Girimonti

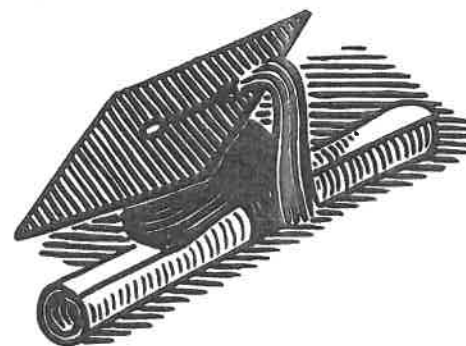

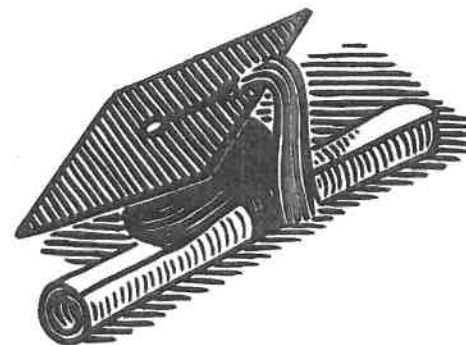
