1. The show is named after Kaila Harlan who was a Huntington alumni. Kaila was diagnosed with leukemia in 2011 and the HHS Key Club held a talent show to raise money for her upcoming surgery. Sadly, Kaila passed away from cancer only a few years later, but her legacy lives on through the show.
2. In the past, K FACTOR has been held to raise money for the American Cancer Society and Relay for Life.
3. After the loss of Rachel Antorino, HHS staff member Aimee Antorino's daughter, K FACTOR began to raise money for Rachel's Dance for the Cure, a foundation created in her memory.
4. All proceeds from our show go to Stonybrook Children's Hospital and the patients who are currently in treatment.
